When one asks who is one of the most influential thinkers in the modern evangelical church, one might be given names such as Jim Packer, John Stott, and Don Carson. I would like to suggest, however, that there is one whose influence is perhaps much greater than we are aware of, yet whose thinking all but pervades the modern evangelical church: Marcion. He's the man who gets my vote for the most profound influence on evangelicalism, from canon to theology to worship practices. You never see his books on the shelves in your high street Christian bookshop; you never see him advertised as preaching in your local church; but his spirit stalks those bookshops and pulpit" (Carl Trueman, *The Marcions Have Landed!*")
